












Progress Indicator #3 HSD programs will be WASC Accredited



5.0 Action Items:

5.1 SAEC Virtual Board Meeting 12.7.21 - Brent Calvin

- AB361 was signed into law by the Governor on 9/17
- AB361 allows public meetings to continue virtually as they have all during COVID-19.
- One difference though is that the board must vote to hold their next meeting virtually. We did not have to do this before AB361. The vote must happen within 30 days of the planned meeting.
- We will now have a standing action item on our agendas to approve virtual meetings so we can be compliant with the law.
