- Visalia Adult School
 - Everyone is off for 15 days with no one on site
 - Will be extending LVN class to make up for lost time
 - ESL teachers have attended two webinar events for Burlington
 - Full-time teachers are monitoring and opening and testing everything that is being done remotely in Edgenuity
 - No GED or HiSet is being given
 - Testing closed
- Corcoran Adult School
 - Students have devices and are in daily contact with teachers
 - Focus is mainly on K12
 - Some ESL students have been contacted by teacher through Zoom
 - Hours will be tracked
- Lindsay Adult School
 - Have temporally suspended all onsite classes
 - Are doing virtual classes
 - Majority of adult learners are working on Edgenuity
 - District is focused on K12 this week
- Reminder that all Edgenuity tests have to be supervised by an instructor
 - All adult schools will bypass giving out the tests
- Hanford Adult School
 - Hanford is completely shut down
 - Not allowed to contact students (zero contact)
 - Only essential staff with approval from the District Office is allowed
 - Suggested that Hanford see Governor Executive Order on 3/13/20
- Plans on capturing Distance Learning hours
 - Schools are working on this and will share information as they have it

- Trying to collect TE Data
 - Packets being given out by Cutler-Orosi
 - Be prepared to give credit on the amount of work you have given students

Gaps

- Student access of devices
- GED and HiSet testing centers are currently closed
 - Pearson Vue is closing down for a while as well as HiSet
- Alpaugh has not network connectivity or devices
- CASAS cancelled
- Collection of student data
- Concerns regarding Benchmark testing
 - Schools were getting ready to test because most students do not come back after spring break
 - This is a long term problem and is being looked at

- > Curriculum: PD for Aztec, Edgenuity, Burlington via Zoom
- Student supportive services
- What will High School Graduation look like
 - May be a motion in Sacramento to ask the Governor to issue executive order to allow LEAs waive graduation requirements to the state allowing 135 credits for graduation
 - Has been a State School Board discussion
- Sponsorships are looking at laxing and waiving some attendance requirements
 - Still in the process of deciding how this will be done
