  - Tulare Adult
    - Started doing orientations for medical program
      - Checked student temperatures
      - Practiced social distancing
    - Plan to start GED testing next week
    - All CTE programs that did not finish will finish this summer
    - Will have online classes this summer except for the medical program
      - · Last medical program is finish up
    - Social distancing was established
  - Visalia Adult
    - Currently only bringing back essential personnel as needed
    - Not moving to do anything in May
    - June is the earliest that GED testing will happen
    - July 1<sup>st</sup> Planning for testing and lottery for CNA and MA classes
    - Hope to finish the 12 hours CNA class still needs in June
      - Can't get into nursing homes. Waiting on CDPH
      - CNA's students that finish the class cannot take state testing to get licenses yet
    - 2 classes that did not start will hopefully start in the Fall
    - Plan on offering 2 night CNA classes instead of one
    - Billing and Coding will take finals in June
    - MA and Welding will come back in August and finish
    - Will be short staff in the LVN department because of retirements
      - Class currently going into their 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester
  - Farmersville Adult
    - Designating a teacher to do Distance Learning
    - Just now thinking about social distancing
  - Cutler-Orosi Adult
    - Evening classes: Looking at running two 90 minute sessions with 10 to 15 students in each
    - Morning classes: No change
  - Lindsay Adult
    - Have already built a distance learning program
    - Looking at opening up the site by appointment only
      - No decisions made yet
